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As a Stock Sorter for our low-cost sports clothes recycling project, you will play a vital role in sorting, organising, cleaning and preparing donated sports clothing and equipment for redistribution. Your attention to detail and commitment to quality control will ensure that donated items are in excellent condition and ready to be reused by those in need. Here's what you'll be doing:

Essential Job Functions

Sorting Donations: Sort through donated sports clothing, footwear, and equipment to assess their condition and quality. Separate items into categories based on type, size, and condition, ensuring that only clean and lightly used items are included in our inventory.

Quality Control: Inspect donated items for any damage, wear, or defects. Remove any items that do not meet our quality standards. Ensure that only items in good condition are included in our inventory for redistribution.

Organization and Inventory Management: Maintain an organised inventory of sorted items and ensure that donated items are stored safely and securely until they are ready for collection.

Cleaning and Preparation: Clean and sanitise donated items as needed to ensure they are ready for reuse. Repair minor damages or defects, such as loose threads or missing buttons, to extend the lifespan of donated clothing and equipment. You will be reimbursed for all cleaning materials.

Team Collaboration: Work closely with other volunteers and staff members to coordinate sorting activities and manage inventory levels. Communicate any issues or concerns regarding donated items to the appropriate personnel.
