When I suffered injury in 2000, I thought my sporting opportunities were over. I had never considered adaptive sport and hadn't really heard about it. That changed when I watched the London Paralympics in 2012 and was inspired by the incredible athletes representing their respective countries.

From that moment on, I knew that I could become active again with the generosity of Help for Heroes, I was able to purchase my first handcycle which helped my fitness and mental well-being.

Fast forward a couple of years and again, witnessing the Invictus Games in London 2014 gave me a renewed sense of competitiveness, and being a Military Veteran, it was something that I wanted to become involved in. I was fortunate enough to represent Team UK in the Toronto 2017 Invictus Games at wheelchair basketball, wheelchair tennis and handcycling. I was also chosen by my teammates to be the flag bearer at the opening ceremony, which was an incredible experience.

I was able to come away from the Games with two bronze medals and lots of personal bests in all the sports I played but more than, being involved in sport again gave me a focus and commitment to my mental and physical health.

This past year had been incredibly difficult for everyone, especially mentally, but knowing that I can keep on handcycling, keep on getting out and about for walks has been a lifesaver for me.

R;pple



We are proud to be partners with Ripple and Alice Hendy, Alice has been making huge waves in the mental health world recently appearing on both the BBC and Sky news so we thought we should tell you a little more about Ripple and what they do and why.

Alice Hendy tragically lost her brother, Josh, on the 25th November 2020 from suicide. Josh was her only sibling, and sadly passed away too soon at just 21 years of age.

Alice's day job involves working in IT and Cyber Security, with experience in working for global financial institutions and insurance firms in the city of London.

After examining Josh's phone and laptop following his death, Alice found that Josh had been researching techniques to take his own life via internet searches, suicide forums and video tutorials.

The content available online following a harmful online search is far too readily available and fails to provide enough of an intervention between a user searching for harmful content and the subsequent display of the search results. To ensure more help and support is given to individuals in mental health crisis and searching for harmful content online, Alice set up R;pple Suicide Prevention.

R;pple addresses the lack of intervention and instead provides an immediate, vibrant display on a user's device once they have been flagged as searching for online content relating to self-harm or suicide.

R;pple is an online nudge technique which consists of a powerful message of hope, as well as providing a selection of mental health support resources in a range of different communicative options (call, text, webchat, self-help app, pocket resources).

Through R;pple, an individual feeling despair and researching harmful content will be urged to instead seek mental health support they deserve and need in a way that works best for them.
